## Pricing

The prices in this document are for those customers taking data directly from Ordnance Survey. Any customers wishing to obtain Ordnance Survey data through an Ordnance Survey Licensed Partner should approach the partner for their prices. Ordnance Survey pricing is based upon corporate pricing. Corporate users are those customers using data on 101 or more terminals. Terminals include laptop, PC or other equipment containing a screen on which licensed data may be displayed or otherwise used.

Unless otherwise stated, Ordnance Survey provides period licences. The price quoted is for an annual licence and covers initial supply, supply of updates where available, use of Ordnance Survey data and any hard copies made.

Orders for additional data placed under an existing contract will be charged up to the end of your then current contract year by calculating the appropriate proportion of the annual licence fee based on the number of days remaining in the contract year.

### Discount for non-corporate data use

Discounts on the corporate price are offered to smaller users. The table below shows the discount you are entitled to for each terminal band:

So, for example, this means that a customer using the data on only five terminals is entitled to a 70% discount on the corporate price.

**Please note that the prices shown for a product against the terminal banding on each page have already been discounted. For example, the annual licence fee for 1:10 000 Scale Raster for use on 3–5 terminals is £46 063.50.**

### Small-area pricing

Sub-corporate users wishing to license areas smaller than Great Britain (GB) should note that certain products have limitations on the level of discount available for areas less than 8% of GB coverage. Please see specific product pages for discounted rates.

## Contract length multipliers (currently only applicable to OS MasterMap® licences)

You can choose the term of your licence, from one to three years. The longer the term of your licence, the more beneficial the end price will be. This incentive is calculated through the application of the following multipliers to the annual licence fee:

## Minimum charges

- 1 The minimum charge for the supply of any Ordnance Survey data (whether it is an initial order of a product or a subsequent order) or for any licence renewal is £100 + VAT per product, unless otherwise stated.
- 2 The minimum charge for adjustment to your licence in all other cases, for example, an increase in terminals, is £50 + VAT.

## OS On Demand fees – web map service

The minimum term for OS On Demand is one (1) year.

The table below indicates the OS On Demand fee (exclusive of VAT) payable for use of the licensed data via OS On Demand.

*NOTE: If your service enhancement is placed during the term of the OS On Demand Agreement, the appropriate proportion of this fee will be charged up to the end of your current OS On Demand agreement year.*

## Products supplied according to GOR

ADDRESS-POINT<sup>®</sup> is supplied and priced according to GOR. There are eleven GORs in total: nine in England, one in Scotland and one in Wales. Each GOR costs 10% of the GB coverage price. Please see price table for corporate prices of full GB coverage.

## Pricing model elements for OS MasterMap data

Each feature within OS MasterMap data carries a unique topographic identifier or TOID<sup>®</sup>. A TOID density model that records the number of TOIDs for the whole of Great Britain based on a 1 km by 1 km grid has been created. Unless otherwise stated, the TOID density within each square kilometre of Great Britain is banded for each product as low, medium or high.

Ordnance Survey works out the price of the data by calculating the size of the area required, finding out which TOID band(s) the area fits into and calculating the corporate price. This is then discounted according to how many terminals the data is supplied for use on.

## OS MasterMap data pricing (including Large-scale mapping)

### Licence fees

This charge covers you in full for standard licensed use of OS MasterMap data, including hard copying. Maintenance is also covered in this charge, and you will have access to change-only updates during the course of your licence period.

## Minimum annual contract value (MACV)

A MACV of £500 will apply to each individual layer of OS MasterMap (that is, Topography, Address, Integrated Transport Network™ and Imagery). This is applied after the terminal discounts but before the contract length multipliers, such that the minimum value of a two-year contract is £960 (£500 x 1.92) per layer, and the minimum value of a three-year contract is £1 380 (£500 x 2.76) per layer.

The minimum charge for expanding an existing contract is £100.

## OS MasterMap Integrated Transport Network (ITN) Layer, Roads Network (RN) theme and Road Routing Information (RRI) theme

In the ITN Layer, the RN theme can be ordered and used as a single theme.

RRI cannot be used independently of the RN.

For the purposes of finding the terminal band discount multiplier, the one-year corporate price of full GB coverage for ITN RN is £109 000 and of ITN RRI is £65 250. Please refer to terminal discounts and small-area pricing table at the end of OS MasterMap data pricing section.

## OS MasterMap Address Layer

Address Layer pricing is not banded. The address TOIDs in the customer's area of interest are added up and priced as follows:

Please note that the number of TOIDs to be charged for is calculated individually for each 1 km square to a resolution of 1% of the 1 km square, or 10 000 square metres rounded to the nearest 1%.

For the purposes of finding the terminal band discount multiplier, the number of address TOIDs in Address Layer is approximately 26 000 000. Please refer to terminal discounts and small-area pricing table at the end of OS MasterMap data pricing section.

The one-year corporate price of full GB coverage for Address Layer is £130 600.

## OS MasterMap Address Layer 2

OS MasterMap Address Layer 2 is offered as an integrated product.

The pricing for Address Layer 2 is the same as for Address Layer, that is the number of TOIDS, terminal discounts and small-area pricing calculations are the same. An uplift of 45% is then applied for the new, more comprehensive data offering contained in Address Layer 2.

## OS MasterMap Prebuild Address Layer

This first release of Prebuild Address Layer will only be available on 1 (one) year contracts.

Terminal banding and small-area pricing does not apply to Prebuild Address Layer because of the relatively low data density and supply by country (England, Scotland or Wales) or national dataset (Great Britain). However, the Minimum Annual Contract Value of £500 does apply.

Customers will also be required to complete a Royal Mail® Not Yet Built™ end-user form.

\*As an addendum to the above pricing matrix, additional per-user fees will be charged by Ordnance Survey if more than 101 users are declared. Up to this figure, Royal Mail royalties will be subsumed in the above prices.

Extra per-user pricing (for more than 101 users) is based on the Royal Mail Not Yet Built licensing.

## Terminal discounts and small-area pricing

The following table indicates the percentage of the price payable for customers taking small areas of coverage that is applied against the corporate price for each OS MasterMap product. The rate is dependent on terminal band and, for small areas, on percentage of the value of GB coverage (for Topography Layer, ITN Layer and Imagery Layer) or on percentage of number of addresses (for Address Layer). The *value* for these purposes is the one-year corporate price of GB coverage, and the percentage is calculated as the proportion of one-year corporate price of the customer's selected area to this *value*. For Address Layer the percentage is the proportion of the number of addresses in the customer's selected area to the number of addresses in the GB dataset.
