

Fraud Prevention and Anti-bribery & Corruption Statement

The Ordnance Survey Group takes a zero-tolerance approach to any form of fraud, bribery or corruption.

Ordnance Survey Limited, Ordnance Survey Leisure Limited, Ordnance Survey International Services Limited (including its overseas branches) and Dennis Maps Limited, the **Ordnance Survey Group**, all recognise the harms caused by fraud, bribery and corruption. As well as being criminal offences, fraud, bribery and corruption lead to financial loss and disruption. They undermine reputation, relationships, and public and business confidence, and also undermine free and fair competition between businesses.

We support and adhere to the Fraud Act 2006, the Bribery Act 2010 and the Economic Crime and Transparency Act 2023, and **confirm our ongoing commitment to carrying out our business fairly, honestly, and openly**. We operate a clear policy and framework for the prevention, detection and investigation of fraud, bribery and corruption.

This means we will:

- only deal with organisations and individuals that share our commitment to preventing fraud, bribery and corruption and will terminate any contract with an organisation or individual involved in fraud, bribery or corruption or that breach our contractual provisions or policies relating to fraud, bribery and corruption prevention;
- review and monitor our policies and procedures to ensure that these support fraud, bribery and corruption prevention, and the safe and confidential disclosure of fraud, bribery or corruption allegations;

- take disciplinary action against any member of staff who actively or knowingly engages in fraud, bribery or corruption.
